Directions From Toronto

From the Gardiner Expressway, head west, continue until the Gardiner turns into the QEW Hamilton
Go through Burlington towards QEW Niagara
Just before the Skyway bridge exit to your right on North Shore Boulevard, turn left on North Shore Blvd.
Go past Joseph Brant Hospital and turn right on Lakeshore (the first stoplight) - You will see the lake on your left.
Go about 1.5 km and you will see signs on your left directing you to the beach (about 500m past the new Beachway Park Pavilion).

Directions from the border (from the west)

From the QEW Niagara before Burlington
Just before the Skyway bridge exit to your right on North Shore Boulevard, turn left on North Shore Blvd.
Go past Joseph Brant Hospital and turn right on Lakeshore (the first stoplight) - You will see the lake on your left.
Go about 1.5 km and you will see signs on your left directing you to the beach (about 500m past the new Beachway Park Pavilion).
